FREE disposal of unused, unwanted or expired medication

Properly disposing of unused medications not only prevents accidental and intentional misuse, but it also helps protect the environment. The Berks County Medication Drop Box program is free for county residents, and ID is not required.

All medication should be placed in the original containers and packaging, with personal information blacked out. Below is a list of items that will be accepted as well as a list of items not collected through this initiative.

Accepted Items

- Prescription medications in standard container or sealed bag with personal information blacked out
- Over-the-counter medications & vitamins
- Drug samples
- Pet medications
- Liquid medications in plastic, leak proof containers
- Ointments, powders, inhalers or patch form medications

Items NOT Accepted

- Loose pills not in standard container or bag
- Syringes
- Thermometers
- Bloody or infectious waste
- Sunblock, lipstick, deodorant & skin cream
- Hydrogen peroxide, cleaning agents & aerosol cans
- Medications from businesses
