- A space that embraces all pathways to recovery.
- A safe place for individuals in recovery to gather for meetings, activities and events.

- The RISE Center is not a drug and alcohol or mental health treatment facility but complements and reinforces the positive changes of the treatment experience.
- The RISE Center is not a clubhouse. Through collaboration with community-based social services, recovery organizations, and volunteers, the RISE Center will create an essential support network for the recovering community.
